The central focus of Tempora Contempora Fest - Winter Edition is the exhibition curated by Giusi Giaracuni and Luigi De Luca, titled Elpís. Prometeo o del sogno infranto di Europa, by Costas Varotsos, hosted at the Castromediano Museum in Lecce, alongside the dance and theater performance Promethean Chain /Anamnesis, created by Greek choreographer Apostolia Papadamaki, featuring a human choir composed of local residents and temporary citizens.

The contemporary imagination, understood as a crossroads of languages and practices, is the horizon in which Tempora/Contempora has always moved, combi-

ning the international dimension with the territorial one.

Coming as premiere from Greece are Apostolia Papadamaki, from Croatia Lana Meniga and Nikolina Prkačin with Ivana Vukovic, from Japan Yui Kawaguchi. The programme includes theater and dance performances alongside new experiences emerging from Salento, within the Accademia Mediterranea dell'Attore. The programme also includes thematic itineraries connecting bodies with well-being and cultural welfare: Promethean fire, bread as the glue of cultures, wine as the propellant of Dionysian fury. Trajectories that highlight experiential approaches and environmental sensitivity towards theatrical habitats to be traversed perhaps on foot with guided tours or by bike with bike tours. The winter edition of Tempora/Contempora welcomes local residents and temporary citizens alike to fully embrace the beauty of our city.


In medieval Japanese folklore, it was believed that old instruments and containers, after existing for one hundred years, would gain a spiritual essence and become "tsukumogami" (a term referring to any object that becomes sentient and alive after its hundredth birthday). In this solo performance, Yui Kawaguchi explores the abyss of aging that connects all living beings, blending elements of folklore with humor and poetry.

**Yui Kawaguchi,** a Japanese dancer and choreographer, trained in Tokyo and has worked in Berlin since 2005. She has collaborated with renowned choreographers and showcased her work at international festivals. Notable works include "Flying Bach" (2010), "The City in the Piano" with Aki Takase, and recent performances such as "The Seven Deadly Sins" (2024).


Inspired by the journey of swallows, Hirundo (the Latin name for this migratory bird) represents an exploration of space, an adaptation attempt preceded by the discovery of an androgynous, foreign body. Movement originates from the hands, symbolizing an extension of creative thought in art. Fragmentation, graphic sharpness, and choreographic suspension merge with abstraction, forming a formal and essential language where body and sound are laid bare for observation and listening.

**Miriana Moschetti,** born in 1995, has studied acting and dance since she was 16. In 2023, she graduated from AMA – Accademia Mediterranea dell'Attore in Lecce, where she currently lives, and from NOHA by Marisa Ragazzo and Omid Ighani. That same year, she participated in the "Vetrina della giovane danza d'autore" within the ANTICORPI XL Dance Network with HIRUNDO (first study), later selected for the "NEW TRAJECTORIES 2023" author training program.



Pupe di Pane is a performance that explores creativity and memory through the ritual of bread-making, symbolizing connection between cultures. Around a workbench called "matthrabbanca," five actresses revive a tradition that spans different dialects and cuisines: the bread dolls. According to director Tonio De Nitto, these dolls were traditionally shaped for Easter as special gifts for children, representing rebirth, protection, and blessing. The ritual of \*Pupe di Pane\* tells the story of strong women who knead and watch over the bread, intertwining their personal lives and stories into the "Great History."

Thematic bike tour with four stops (Teatro Paisiello, Roman Theatre, Roman Amphitheatre and Museum Castromediano) starting from Convitto Palmieri and ending at the Museum Castromediano, where the exhibition "Elpís. Prometeo o del sogno infranto di Europa" by Greek sculptor Costas Varotsos, curated by Giusi Giaracuni and Luigi De Luca, will be visited.

**La Ciclofficina Popolare (CPK)** is a project born from Associazione Ruotando and funded by the Puglia Region, inaugurated on May 21, 2012, at the Manifatture Knos in Lecce. It is the city's first bike workshop, promoting bicycles as an ecological, healthy, and quick means of transport, rescuing bikes destined for the landfill. The workshop is open to everyone and allows for free bike repairs or recycling, fostering social integration and the revival of manual skills. It also provides a space for sharing passion for everyday cycling as a step toward a better world.
